Students Calligraphy Competition and International Academic Symposium (Seoul 2018)

- I. Purpose:
- To encourage students to understand the wisdom of the Ancient classics in Chinese.
- To promote social awareness of the cultural traditions of Korea and China and thousands of years of cultural exchange through calligraphy.
- To encourage students to engage in cultural studies from different perspectives, using English translation, multi-lingual reading, and new media technology to appreciate and illustrate the beauty of Korean poetry in Chinese.
- To appreciate cultural traditions by holding a calligraphy competition and publishing works of students through their research and artistic appreciation.

IV. Support by Consulate General of the Republic of Korea in Hong Kong

- V. Calligraphy competition rules: Each participating university select 6 pieces of calligraphy by students from their university.
  - 1. Participants must be current students or alumni graduated in the last 5 years.
  - 2. The subject and contents of calligraphy must be related to Korean and Chinese ancient Classics.
  - Calligraphy fonts can be in any style. Size of artwork: 4 ft. half size (no bigger than 91.5cm x 183cm).
  - 4. Participants must submit an 800 to 1000 words article in Korean, Chinese or English on the background and reasons for the artwork.
  - Deadline for submission: 31<sup>st</sup> August 2018, selection result will be announced by 30<sup>th</sup> September.
  - 6. Award Ceremony will be held during October /November 2018 in Seoul.
    - Science and Art Students Calligraphy Awards (Seoul 2018) 1st prize: one Korean winner and one Chinese winner 2nd prize: one Korean winner and one Chinese winner 3rd prize: one Korean winner and one Chinese winner Masterpiece Prize: six Korean students and six Chinese students
- VI. Remarks:
  - Each participating university will submit 6 pieces of calligraphy artworks by students to participate in the calligraphy competition and seminars held in Seoul.
  - Participating students will pay for their own flight and accommodation costs. This can come from their own university's sponsorship.
  - Invited renowned academicians and scholars will be the judges of the competition.
  - Each participant is recommended to read and appreciate Korean or Chinese quotes, sayings, poems from *Collection of works from Classical Korean works in Chinese (Han'guk Yoktae Munjip Chongso (韓國歷代文集叢書)* and *Si Ku Quan Shu (四庫全書)*
  - All award winning works will be collected, edited, and published in a monography for global scholarly community.
