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




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URECA Papers for OAPS Collection

1. Papers from highly selected undergraduate research programme

Agreement with Director of URECA (Undergraduate Research Experience on CAmpus) Programme to have a selection of top papers deposited in DR-NTU (Open Access) - URECA Collection from 2014 onwards. These papers will be then showcased in the NTU's OAPS webpage.

2. The Workflow

In the plan, supervisors will review and identify suitable papers, as part of a online submission process, according to these agreed criteria:

- The research paper follows methodologies that are acceptable to scholarly practice in the respective disciplines;
- The paper is written clearly and coherently and in accordance with the prescribed format of an acceptable style manual;
- It is written with academic honesty and integrity, i.e. it is free from plagiarized content as far as it can be ascertained;
- The paper has contributed to knowledge creation or advancement.

The IT team is currently working to incorporate the selection functionality into the online submission workflow for URECA papers. It is expected to be ready for the June 2014 submissions.

Feedback on Checklist for Submission of OAPS Paper

Subject librarians involved in obtaining OAPS papers were concerned that faculty may be discouraged from nominating papers by having to process the Checklist.

<u>Counter-proposal</u>:

- A simplified **Nomination Form** to be used instead.
- It will contains all the essential points from the Checklist.
- Combining practicality and ease of use, while fulfilling the rigour of selection.

- Part 1 of Nomination Form will be emailed by Subject Librarians to the Schools for their input.
- Subject Librarians will also help to pre-fill-up some information (e.g. names of nominator or endorser).
- Selection criteria is clearly stated and implicitly agreed when papers are nominated.

- These papers are among the best in the cohort of the year in the department/school.
- These papers follow methodologies that are acceptable to scholarly practice in the respective disciplines.
- These papers are written clearly and coherently and in accordance with the prescribed format of an acceptable style manual.
- These papers are written with academic honesty and integrity (i.e. it is free from plagiarized content as far as it can be ascertained).
- These papers have contributed to knowledge creation or advancement.

- Fulfils the rigour of selection without imposing extra work for schools.

Nomination of Student Papers for OAPS Collection (Part 2)

To be completed by Subject Librarian

- 1. Basic elements of a good academic paper are present. The paper include:
 - a. An abstract
 - b. A review of literature
 - c. A clear statement of thesis
 - d. Discussion of findings
 - e. Conclusion
 - f. References
- 2. The reference list is properly cited and follows a standard citation style.
- 3. Sources used in supporting the paper appear to be reliable, stable and verifiable.
