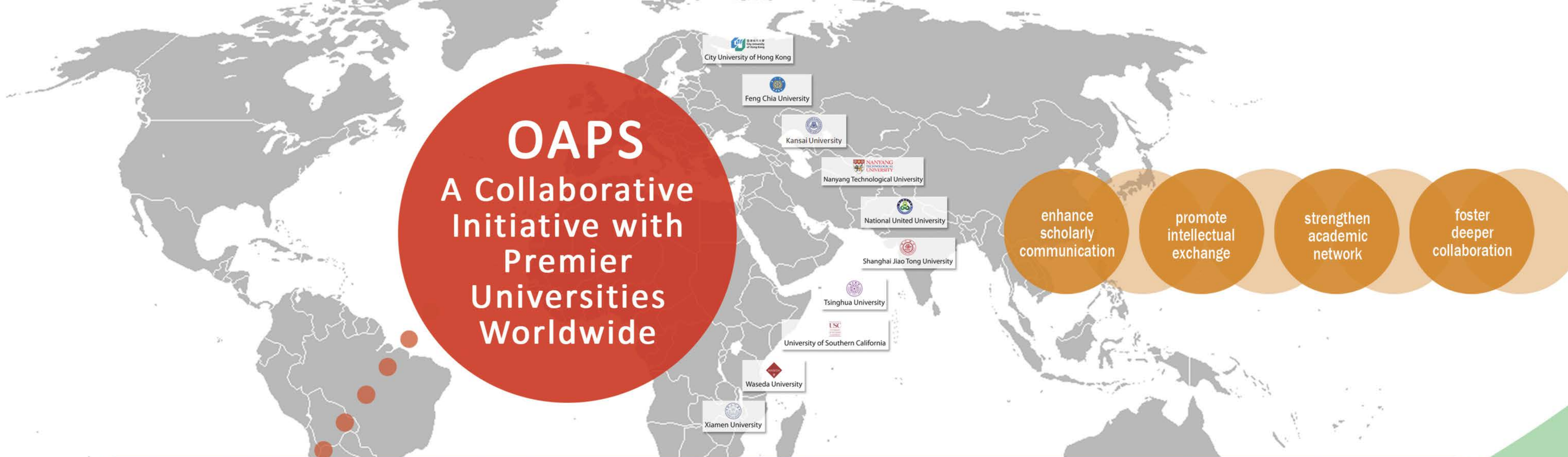


OAPS Workflow

Stage 1: Knowledge Creation

- ❖ Promote OAPS via campus-wide announcement, library website, leaflet, etc.
- ❖ Provide instruction services – workshops, online courses, research guides on information search skills, citation style, Refworks, etc.

Stage 2: Paper Collection & Management

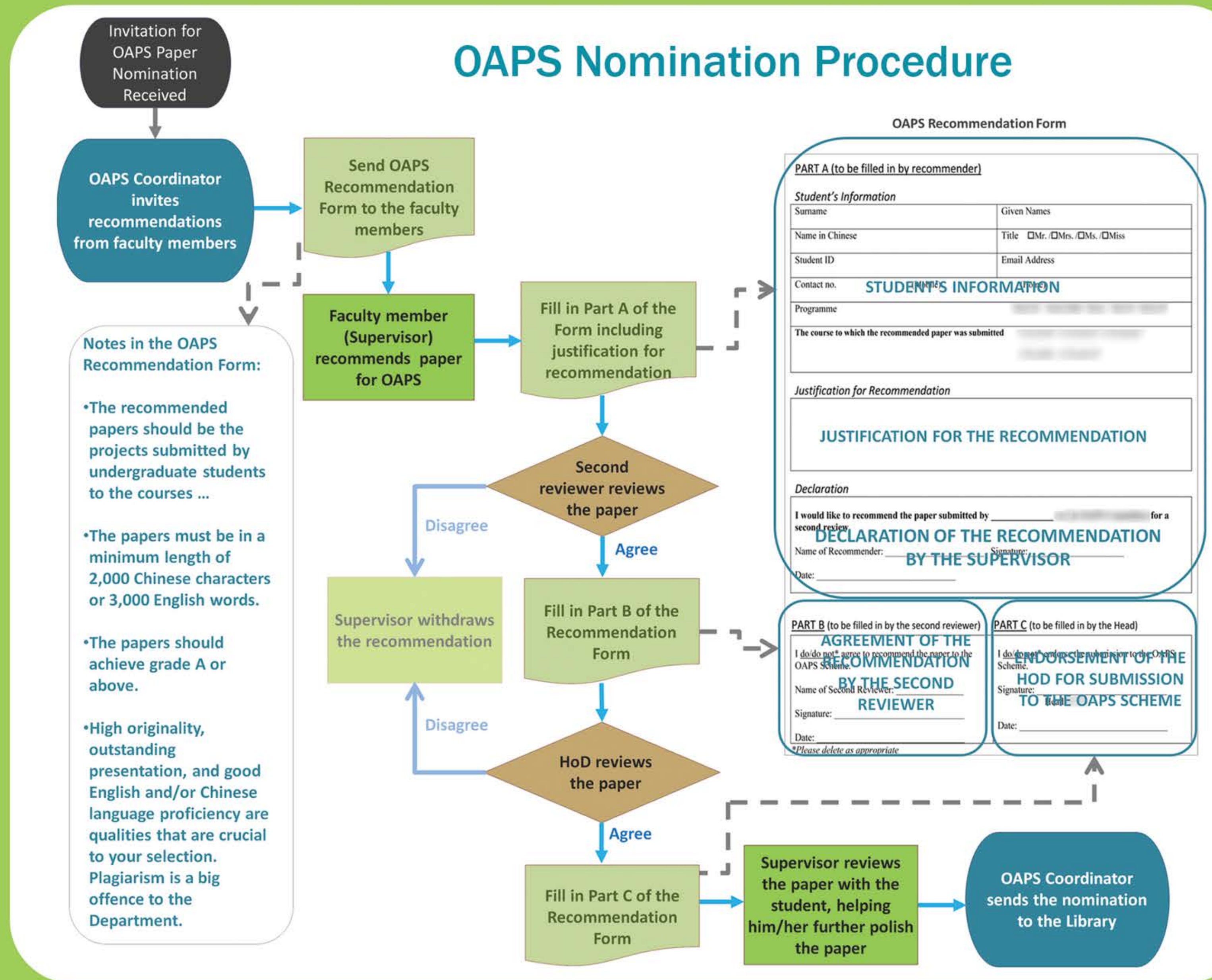
- ❖ Invite OAPS submission via campus-wide announcement, email and phone.
- ❖ Collect outstanding student papers from academic departments.

The selection of papers or nomination procedure is currently administered by participating departments. A common practice adopted by most departments is summarized as follows:

Stage 1: Individual faculty member submits nomination to HoD/approving committee.

Stage 2: HoD/approving committee review all nominations and select best papers (i.e. grade A- or above) for OAPS submission.

The diagram shows an example of the OAPS nomination procedure implemented in a CityU academic department.

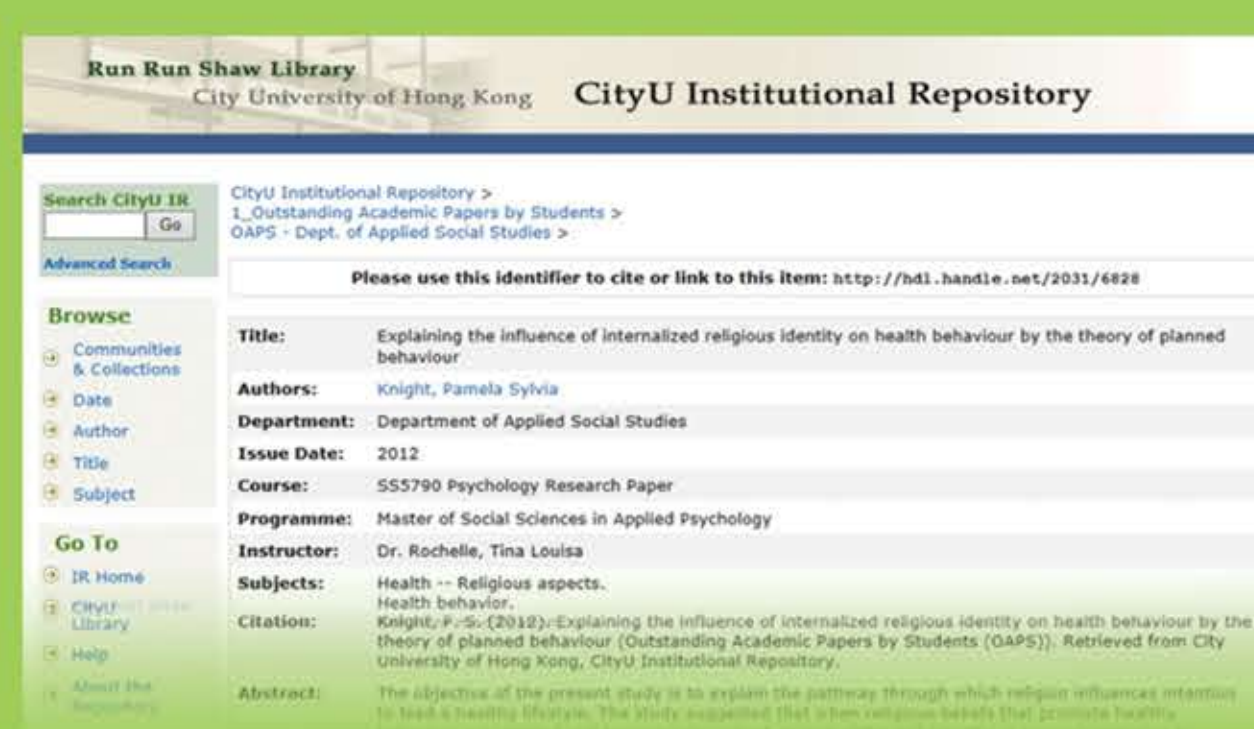


- ❖ Run nominated papers on SafeAssign, plagiarism detection software & invite the relevant faculty members to view the SafeAssign assessment reports.
- ❖ Contact the authors to declare copyright clearance of any third-party copyrighted matter and for approval to archive the papers in CityU IR for open access.

Stage 3: Publishing

- ❖ Create metadata & upload the papers to OAPS Collection in CityU Institutional Repository, with a citation of the paper in APA style on the cover page created for each OAPS paper so as to help the readers to cite the paper properly.

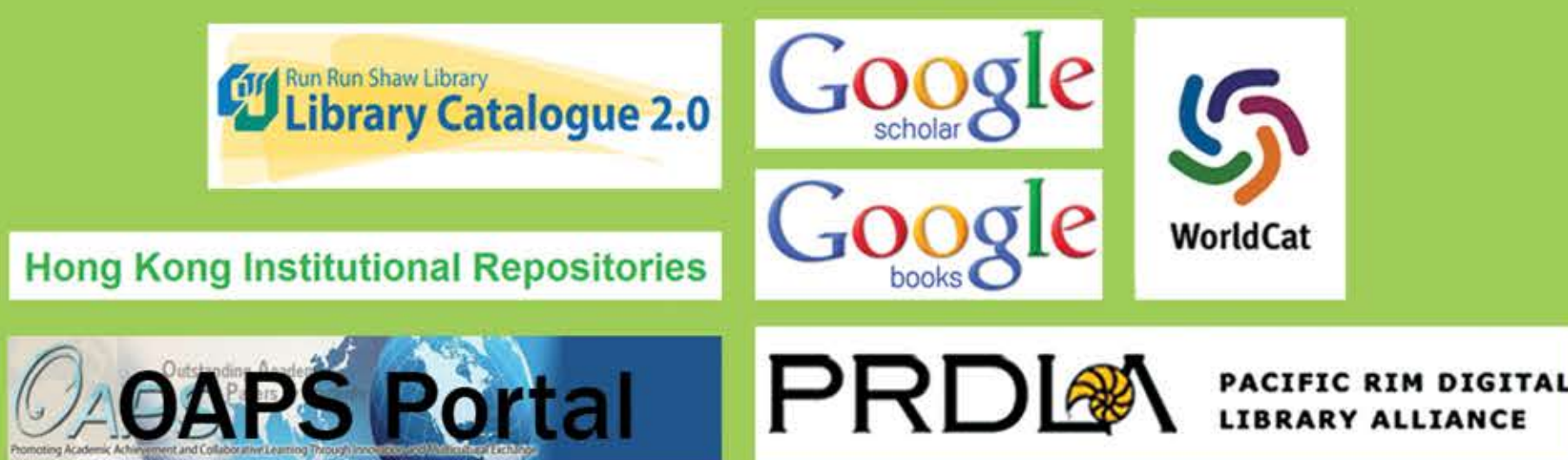

Besides the CityU Institutional Repository, the OAPS papers are accessible via the Library Catalogue and a number of widely-used searching platforms for scholarly literature such as Google Scholar, WorldCat, and PRDLA (Pacific Rim Digital Library Alliance).



Google Scholar Citations

The CityU OAPS papers are gaining global readership. According to Google Scholar in February 2014, 40 of 294 CityU's OAPS papers have been cited by scholars or students worldwide, representing 13.6% of the papers. Seven papers have been cited two times, making the total number of cites 47.

- ❖ Award students certificates and OAPS booklets in the annual Certificate Awarding Ceremony; CityU & external guests are invited to attend the Ceremony.



Stage 4: Publicity

- ❖ Showcase the OAPS papers in the Library.



- ❖ Report the OAPS developments and events, archive them and make the information available on CityU websites.
